GIFF 21: SWISS SERIES LIGHT UP THE 27th FESTIVAL

The Geneva International Film Festival (GIFF) unveils three highlights of the upcoming event (November 5 to 14) with a trio of original Swiss series: the world premiere screenings of SACHA by Léa Fazer and Nicole Castioni, TSCHUGGER by David Constantin and an evening devoted to the complete series of LA VIE DE J.C. by ZEP. Each of these screenings, accompanied by their thrilling cast, will spotlight Switzerland's impressive diversity in terms of serial works and their power to unite the public.

For this 27th Festival, GIFF once again pays allegiance to the creative power of serial storytelling. With a rich program including an International Series Competition – unique in Switzerland – and the European Script Award, the Festival will shine the spotlight on the country's dynamism with three major productions. The already cult series *LA VIE DE J.C.*, created by ZEP and directed by Gary Grenier, will bring together its flamboyant cast during an exceptional evening, on the occasion of the presentation of the complete series, including the last six episodes which have never been screened before. A pair of world premieres will introduce two pilot episodes to the public before going to air in the presence of the teams and casts. Director Léa Fazer's adaptation of Nicole Castioni's text in *SACHA* will immerse the audience in an incredible story freely inspired by the former Geneva judge's life. Finally, David Constantin's hilarious thriller *TSCHUGGER*, in the Upper Valais dialect, will showcase Eastern Switzerland's dark sense of humor.

Synopsis: Anne Dupraz, a respected and feared prosecutor, is in custody for shooting a man who is now between life and death. She admits her guilt but seems unable to explain her act. Her interrogation and that of her relatives will enable Anne to finally free herself from her past. With this adaptation of Nicole Castioni's account, Léa Fazer has created a thriller that doubles as a quest for identity and femininity in a narrative with skillfully arranged temporal interlacing.

In a series that is as irreverent as it is hilarious, Zep carries out a project that is so close to his heart that he agreed to get behind the camera for the first time to tell the dream life of Jesus Christ in 20 three-minute episodes.

The three series will also be available on <u>Play Suisse</u>, GIFF's streaming partner, after the 27th Festival.
